WHAT IS THIS ANNEX ABOUT AND WHEN IT IS RELEVANT TO YOU

This annex to the CNH Global Privacy Statement contains additional information and details which are specific to Argentina.

This annex is relevant to you if:

- your Personal Data is processed by an CNH entity established at Argentina.
- you are a Argentina resident, and your Personal Data is processed by a CNH entity Argentina that carries on business in the country which includes actively collecting Personal Data.

APPLICABLE DATA PROTECTION LAWS

The primary Data Protection law in Argentina is the Personal Data Protection Law – nº 25.326 – "PDPL" (regulated by Decree nº 1558/2001), and the regulation that gives guidance about the international data transfer is RESOLUTION AAIP No. 198/2023, OF OCTOBER 18, 2023, which approved the Standard Contractual Clauses for International Personal Data Transfers, available here: [Transferencias internacionales — Agencia de Acceso a la Información Pública](#)

LEGAL JUSTIFICATION FOR THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA UNDER PDPL

The PDPL provides legal justifications for the processing of Personal Data (Article 5 of the PDPL). Under the PDPL, at least one of these must apply for the processing of Personal Data to be lawful.

You can find an explanation of the legal justifications for the processing of your Personal Data in Section 3 of the Privacy Statement.

INTERNATIONAL DATA TRANSFERS

The international transfer of personal data will be limited to the minimum necessary to achieve its purposes, covering data that is relevant, proportionate and not excessive in relation to the purposes of the data processing.

In case your Personal Data is transferred from Argentina to recipients in other countries, we will ensure that the recipient of your Personal Data offers an adequate level of protection. In the event this is not possible we may transfer Personal Data only with your consent or in specific circumstances identified by the law.

Cross-border data transfers can be carried out if one of the following conditions is met:

- **Legal Basis:** one of the legal hypotheses provided for in Article 5 of the PDPL; and
- **Countries or international organizations:** that provide a degree of personal data protection adequate to that provided in the PDPL, and in complementary rules, as recognized by DNPDP Disposition No. 60/2016 and AAIP Resolution No. 34/2019;
- **Standard Contractual Clauses:** as approved by AAIP Resolution No. 198/2023;
- **Binding Corporate Rules (Normas Corporativas Vinculantes):** as established by AAIP Resolution No. 159/2018;
- **Specific contractual clauses,** subject to prior approval by the AAIP; or
- **Express consent** of the data subject, previously informed of the purpose of the transfer and the identity of the recipient.

TRANSPARENCY MEASURES

In accordance with Article 6 of Argentina's Personal Data Protection Law (Law No. 25,326 — "PDPL"), the data controller must inform the data subject, prior to data collection, of the purpose for which the data will be processed and who the recipients of the data will be. This section is intended to provide information about international data transfers carried out between CNH entities in Argentina and around the world.

SECURITY MEASURES AND RESPONSABILITIES

The PDPL determines that the data controller or user of the data file must adopt the technical and organizational measures necessary to guarantee the security and confidentiality of personal data, in order to prevent its adulteration, loss, unauthorized access or processing, and to allow the detection of intentional or unintentional deviations of information, whether the risks arise from human action or from the technical means used (Article 9). The controller and any persons involved in any phase of the processing of personal data are also bound by a duty of confidentiality with respect to such data, which subsists even after the relationship with the data controller has ended (Article 10).

YOUR PRIVACY RIGHTS

You may exercise the following rights in accordance with the PDPL (Law No. 25,326, Articles 5, 13, 14, 16, 20 and 29):

- Right to be informed of the existence of files, registries, or databases containing your personal data, their purposes, and the identity of those responsible (Article 13);
- Right to access your personal data included in public or private databases (Article 14);
- Right to rectification, updating, deletion, or confidentiality (blocking) of your personal data (Article 16);
- Right to withdraw your consent at any time (Article 5);
- Right to challenge decisions based solely on the automated processing of personal data that define your profile or personality (Article 20);
- Right to file a complaint regarding data processing before the Agencia de Acceso a la Información Pública (AAIP) (Article 29); and

- Right to clear and free information about who processes your data and for what purpose (Articles 6 and 13).
